GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION & PROMOTION:

- Diocesan Board of Education has directed all the Stewart Schools for Continuous Comprehensive
 Evaluation from class I to VIII by adopting creative and child friendly method. Also directed the
 Principals to prepare a scheme for Continuous ComprehensiveEvaluation by which each child can
 be evaluated and remedial steps can be taken for further improvement. As a result there will be
 no failures of any student till class VIII. Special case should be taken by the concerned school for
 the weaker student in order toenable them to be promoted to the next class.
- The Diocesan Board of Education is conducting the Common Examination in class IX in HalfYearly and Annual in all the Stewart Schools. The questions have been set by the DiocesanBoard of Education and the answer scripts are centrally evaluated in the school under thesupervision of Principal and Co-Ordinator. All such answer scripts are preserved for a period of one year for the inspection by the Diocesan Board of Education.
- The Diocesan Board of Education is conducting the Common Mock Test & Selection Test inclass X in all the Stewart Schools. The questions have been set by the Diocesan Board of Education and the answer scripts are centrally evaluated in the school under the supervision of Principal and Co-Ordinator. All such answer scripts are preserved for a period of one year for the inspection by the Diocesan Board of Education.
- To keep a parity in all the Stewart Schools, the Diocesan Board of Education is preparing the common book list and also common syllabus for all the Stewart Schools since 2001.
- If a student's parent / relative is working as a teacher in the school then invigilation duty in the same room of the student not to be given at any circumstances.
- Aii office staff and Nurses not being teaching staff shall also be given invigilation duty during School examinations.
- As per RTE ACT, 2019
 1[16. (1) There shall be a regular examination in the fifth class and in the eighth class at the end of every academic year.
 - (2) If a child fails in the examination referred to in sub-section (1), he shall be given additional instruction and granted opportunity for re-examination within a period of two months from the date of declaration of the result.

The matter to be decided in the Managing Committee and accordingly decision will be taken.
